I-66 Express Mobility Partners, the Virginia Department of Transportation's (VDOT) partner on the Transform 66 Outside the Beltway Project, plans to construct a park & ride lot in the northeast corner of the I-66 and Route 29 interchange (Exit 43) at University Blvd. in Gainesville to make it easier for commuters to use transit or carpool. The design includes bus bays, passenger shelters, bicycle racks, a pick up/drop off area, and future access to and from the I-66 Express Lanes.

This public hearing is focused solely on the planned design of the University Blvd. park & ride lot. Public hearings will be held in November on the planned roadway improvements to I-66 Outside the Beltway.
