## **I-66 PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETINGS NEXT WEEK**

*Public invited to learn about plans to transform I-66 between  
U.S. Route 15 in Haymarket and I-495/Capital Beltway in Fairfax County*

WHAT: The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), in partnership with the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT), will hold Public Information Meetings about plans to transform 25 miles of I-66 outside the Beltway into a multimodal corridor that provides congestion relief and new travel choices. The meetings are intended to gain public input and provide information about alternatives being evaluated for I-66, including key interchanges, express lanes, high-frequency bus service with predictable travel times, and direct access to new or expanded commuter lots.
